**Footnotes**

LA SORPRESA made up ground from outside on the backstretch, was five wide through the second turn, battled through the lane and moved ahead in the waning yards. PLEASE N TERAS bumped with GIRL CON at the start, progressed from inside, came off the rail some on the second turn, made her way through traffic leaving that bend, went for the lead between rivals at the head of the lane, fought gamely but did not have enough left nearing the wire. DREAM KIN contested the pace between horses on the backstretch, was in path three through the second bend, had a narrow advantage upper stretch but slowly yielded the final sixteenth. GLORY BE MINE soon had the lead and the inside, was challenged on the backstretch and began to wear down the last furlong. SETUSTRAIT moved up to contender from between horses on the backstretch, had to weave through traffic to advance on the second turn, was just off the rail entering the lane, advanced to midstretch then hung. TREADING WATER was a factor between rivals for more than a half mile, could not keep up three wide into the second turn but passed some tired ones in the stretch. GIRL CON bumped with PLEASE N TERAS at the start then failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. MYLILMEMO trailed while staying off the inside, was four to six wide through the second turn, lugged in some midstretch and had no late bid. TERAS BABY was away slowly, rushed up to contention while toward the outside, began to back up taking the second bend four then five wide and was empty for the drive. AMBERS PRIDE displayed early speed just outside DREAM KIN but gave way four wide the last quarter mile.
