Footnotes

SAPELLO CANTADOR rated off the inside, gradually progressed from path three on the backstretch, passed rivals from outside on the second bend, floated out to path four entering the lane, drifted out then lugged in as he rallied but got up in time. GOTTA MOVE soon had the lead, set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved clear on the second turn, tried hard to hold on in the stretch, did not have enough left but was clearly second best. GODZIA a step slow at the break, was settled inside, picked up his pace after a half mile, swung outside on the second turn, came six wide into the stretch, steadily advanced and took over third late. LE GRANDE'S SPIRIT pressed the early speed from between horses, followed GOTTA MOVE through the second turn, altered outside that one upper stretch and slowly yielded. AMOROSO took the rail on the first turn, stayed well placed inside to the lane then also gradually wore down. ONE FINE JEWEL void of speed while toward the outside, lodged a mild bid just off the inside entering the second turn, fanned out behind LE GRANDE'S SPIRIT into the stretch, altered out for a clear path nearing the eighth pole but failed to have a significant response. DESERT GULCH vied for the early lead from inside, was checked in tight quarters leaving the first turn, continued to retreat just off the inside on the backstretch, floated out some entering the stretch and was empty. DIESEL INJUN pressed from outside, failed to keep up three wide on the second turn, drifted out some into the lane and steadily gave way.
