Footnotes

TRICK SHOT pressed from outside, bid for the lead on the turn, angled in some to be three wide entering the lane, edged ahead inside the last furlong and moved clear under urging inside the final sixteenth. EL COCO MAN bumped with PATRONESS KATHY at the start, disputed the pace two wide, gained the rail leaving the turn, tried hard through the lane but did not have enough left. MIGHTY TO SAVE disputed the pace just outside EL COCO MAN but gradually wore down for the drive. PERKINSVILLE jostled briefly with GRAND DECREE at the break, was without early speed from inside, swung five wide into the lane, drifted out some upper stretch and altered out to stay clear of MILEAGE inside the last eighth. MILEAGE chased from outside, came four wide into the lane, weaved out then back in after entering the final furlong, finished evenly but was easily best of the rest. BURBANK TOO also jostled with GRAND DECREE at the start, was void of speed, just off the rail on the bend and passed some tired ones in the stretch. QUALITY STORM displayed early speed between horses, was caught in tight quarters four wide into the turn, failed to keep up leaving the bend, fanned out to path six and steadily gave way. PATRONESS KATHY well placed inside, began to tire leaving the turn, floated out some entering the stretch and faded between rivals. GRAND DECREE jostled between horses at the break, showed no speed, stayed well off the inside taking the turn and had no late bid. ANITA was soon far back, saved ground through the bend and was unresponsive in the lane.
