FAMED CITY was unhurried early, looped the field leaving the second turn then drew off smartly and won with something left. RUN AWAY SUE made a middle move, swung six wide and was up for the place while no match for the winner. MAJESTIC MOOD stalked the early leaders, bid between rivals in the stretch then weakened late. SPIRIT OF FLAG dueled to mid stretch then gave way. LYNDY LOU raced evenly. JOVIAL NOTE was hard used disputing the pace and faded late. CARAVEL PORT gradually weakened. STORMY MIST hesitated at the start, was wide early then stopped. SILVER CORD failed to menace. The temporary rail was set out 22 feet.
