CALIBOGUE SOUND was never far back, rallied out of the second turn, challenged PRIVATE ANOUSH leaving the furlong marker then was all out to narrowly prevail under strong handling. ACROSS THE CREEK was boxed and steadied in traffic through the second turn, angled inside for the drive, got through along the rail in mid stretch to draw even with the leaders then just missed. PEER REVIEW made an inside middle move then took up sharply behind a tiring rival passing the quarter pole, swung five wide then closed fast to also just miss. PRIVATE ANOUSH broke sharp to gain the early lead, was well handled setting a moderate pace then just hung late after a long drive. NATIVE WAGER closed a gap late. LITE MEDLEY stalked the pace inside for six furlongs and faded. OZILDA'S KAREN chased to the quarter pole then gave way. FOREVER SONIC trailed. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
