STEPASIDE made a middle move, angled out four wide after five furlongs then rallied past the leader leaving the furlong grounds to be along in time. QUITE A DUDE set a fast pace, shook clear in the drive but hung late while saving the place. THABAZIMBI raced close up, bid leaving the second turn but was outkicked. KEEPING THE HONOR passed tiring rivals. RAILROAD saved ground but had no rally. MACHO CHICK passed faders. OFFICER'SGENTLEMAN chased for six furlongs then gave way. GOLD PAGEANTRY also chased to the stretch then came up empty. CONRAD CROSSING dueled then faded. BEANTOWN was no factor.
