Footnotes

DEERBOROUGH stalked the pace for six furlongs, bid three wide into the stretch then drew off smartly leaving the furlong marker. SCRUPLES IN sprinted clear, set a solid pace but was no match for the winner while saving the place. SHINE ON made a middle move to challenge outside into the stretch but failed to sustain that bid. BEEN AWHILE weakened gradually. SPEEDER failed to threaten. CONRAD CROSSING chased for six furlongs then faded. DEAD RED was no factor.
