### Footnotes

TRI POWER dueled from outset, turned back one bid from IT'S ABOUT IMAGE out of the second turn then continued gamely through a long drive to just last. BONNISTAR was void of early speed, got through along the inside in the drive then finished well late to just miss. IT'S ABOUT IMAGE stalked the pace early, bid three wide after a half then continued gamely to late before just hanging. CONSTABULARY was void of early speed, swung five wide out of the second turn then also finished well but too late. D' WILDCARD bid from between rivals in the drive then bumped with MARCH TWELTH in the drive. MARCH TWELTH stalked for six furlongs, bid inside in the drive then bumped with D' WILDCAT in the stretch. DUAL FORECAST was no factor. GLORY CHARGE stopped.
