RON'S PERENNIAL broke sharp, set a quick pace under good handling then after turning back a bid from OUT IN THE OPEN through the furlong grounds, shook clear late. OUT IN THE OPEN was hard to load, chased outside, bid through the furlong grounds then just hung late while second best. HEARTACHES made a middle move to the furlong grounds but failed to gain late. SKIP THE FLIP chased into the stretch then weakened. AMERICA'S CHOICE was well placed but had no rally. TAXICAB raced evenly. YANKEESSWEPTINFOUR weakened gradually. SURVI STAR was well placed inside then gave way. MARTICUS THE GREAT failed to menace. LITTLE MAN was no factor. A SONG FOR SARAH came out at the break then showed little.

QUIET CHRIS trailed.
