SMOOTH DADDY RYAN made a middle move then was up late for the place while no threat to the winner. SOLE RUNNER looped four wide out of the turn then lodged a mild rally. ZUBER passed tiring rivals. FRANKS REWARD was fractious in the gate then was no factor. BEIJING HOUSE was hard used disputing the pace to the stretch then gave way. STAR DISTINCTION raced well off the inner rail while disputing the pace for a half then faded. CARNIVAL RIDE trailed.
