RIGHT FLANKER dueled for five furlongs, drew off from the quarter pole and was clearly best under intermittent pressure. KALITA was restless in the starting gate then broke slowly, advanced through traffic to get through along the rail and be closest to the winner in the drive but couldn't gain on that one while best of the rest. CRUZAN VALOR lodged a mild belated rally. FORESTRY PRINCE was well placed but had no rally. CALL IN ADVANCE chased outside then gradually weakened. BRUNZER dropped back to last after a half then came back on again late. MARTINI PEGASUS failed to menace. SON OF A SAILORMAN was through early. DILIGENT BID stopped. WORLD JAMBOREE broke down approaching the furlong marker.
