ELISSA GREELEY broke alertly, set a slow pace, repulsd bids out of the second turn to draw off to mid stretch then held sway late. ANCIENT EYES came in after the break, raced close up early, bid three wide after five furlongs but weakened in the drive while saving the place. OCCULTATION was in tight and forced to check after the break, checked up again behind horses in the first turn, looped rivals four wide to challenge out of the second turn then also weakened in the drive. LUCKY BREW was void of early speed then closed a gap but too late. WADOCASHSKI pressed the pace to the stretch then gave way. JAMIE'S TICKET faded after a half. JUSTOUTOFTHEBLUE was no factor. THE QUARTER TIME WAS HAND TIMED.
