JULIET TANGO was shuffled back in traffic early, recovered to swing wide out of the second turn then ran down the leader from the outside in the final strides. HIGH CRY raced boxed inside through the second turn, waited for racing room into the stretch then got through along the rail to gain a short lead into the final furlong only to be caught late. PARIS BY NIGHT made a middle move then was gaining ground in traffic late. SPECIAL JAK was void of speed to the stretch then closed a gap but too late. BUTTERDISH came in leaving the chute, stalked the pace for six furlongs then bid into the stretch before weakening in the final furlong. BELLS OF CONCERTO dueled to mid stretch then weakened. REPUBLICAN was in tight early then was no factor. CHLOE CAROL dueled into the stretch then came up empty. TATY'S GOLD was well placed for six furlongs then faded. THE REAL FUTURE showed little.
