SONG OF NORA was unhurried early, made a four wide middle move to contention then ran down the leader late under brisk handling. ANAPEST broke sharp, set a moderate pace under good handling then resisted the winner well to late before hanging and outfinishing the rest. MISS OOH LA LA made a quick three wide middle move, bid out of the second turn then weakened late under pressure. AFLEET ANGEL stalked the pace three wide but failed to respond when called upon. HALO'S WILDCAT raced boxed inside from the second turn to the furlong grounds but had no rally. MISS SMART STRIKE failed to menace. COZIE ADVANTAGE was no factor. MEGAN'S CRACKER stopped. PAR GOLFER showed little. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
