ZOOMING WHITE STAR was fractious in the gate, made a middle move to contention then after looming boldly outside in the drive, just hung late. MASKED MAN lugged out early, advanced inside through the turn, swung to the middle of the track in the furlong grounds then lodged a mild bid late. STORM HOPE raced evenly. HOLY FIT rushed to the lead from the inside then dueled into the stretch before fading. PURELY PRECIOUS also dueled to the stretch before giving way. PAPA MIA trailed to late. BOLD CAT stopped.
