SEE I A stalked the pace for a half, bid three wide into the furlong grounds then shook clear late under brisk handling. GARY D chased the leader early, bid after three furlongs, shook clear in mid stretch but hung late while saving the place. GOOD LORD angled outside then closed a gap but too late. GUAM TYPHOON was well placed into the stretch but failed to gain. SINCERO passed tiring rivals. A DIEHL also passed faders. TOMMY'S MEMORY chased for a half then faded. WILDCAT FRANKIE sprinted clear early, resisted to mid stretch then faltered. PRINCE JOSHUA was through early. STORMIN BUD was no factor.
