WHAT A SWEEP stalked the early pace, bid four wide into the second turn then continued gamely through a long drive and was all out to outduel CRIMSON FLAG through a prolonged drive. CRIMSON RISING chased early, bid three wide into the second turn then also continued gamely through a long drive before just hanging late while second best. OUR CHEQUER FLAG checked up in the first turn, raced close up to the stretch but failed to gain once clear. OUR LEGEND raced wide throughout. ALLY'S VALENTINE raced evenly. GLORIA GOLD CROSS dueled to the second turn then gave way. MONA LADY was hard used disputing the pace for six furlongs then faded. JUST ONE KISS failed to menace. AUGUST GAME showed little. NAUGHTY DREADLOCKS was no factor.
