WILLSBORO POINT was unhurried early, advanced after five furlongs to challenge for the lead into the stretch, drove clear leaving the furlong grounds then lasted late. BEIJING HOUSE was void of early speed, angled out four wide in the second turn then finished willingly outside the winner through the late stages. MARQUET CAT sprinted to a long early lead, resisted to the final furlong then weakened. ROCK LOBSTER made up some ground late. LUCKMAN passed tiring rivals. KAUFMAN was well placed for six furlongs then faded. NOBLE TIGER showed little. MAKAAAN chased then came up empty. DEERBOROUGH also chased to the stretch then stoipped.
