J ISLE also vied for the lead throughout and came again late to just miss. LAST STAR stalked the pace into the stretch, split rivals in the furlong grounds to challenge, gained a short lead inside the final furlong then just hung in deep stretch. SLING SHOT TOO broke slow, rushed up inside to gain the lead into the turn, continued gamely to late then also just hung. DOUBLE REVIVAL closed a gap too late. L. G.'S FLASH vied to the quarter pole then faded. SHORT CUT raced evenly. BARRY MEATBALL was no fctor. MESNEBEE showed little.
