STORMY GOING broke sharp, set a moderate pace while racing slightly, settled into the stretch with a clear lead then just lasted. YES THIS IS IT stalked the pace inside, got through along the rail into the stretch then was slowly gaining on the winner late. MIDDIE angled outside on the backstretch then lodged a mild rally late. FACTUAL chased into the stretch then weakened. ONLY WIN stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs then weakened. STREET FLYER raced evenly. CACAWAY weakened gradually. HEAT SHIELD was no factor. WILL RUN FOR BEER showed little. HIGH BAR was no factor.
