GIACOMO THE GREAT (VEN) pressed the leader from the outset, dueled through a long drive then drew off late. SLEW CITY SIN set a moderate pace into the final furlong before weakening late while saving the place. TURN RED was well placed but offered only a mild late rally. INDIAN LINE broke through the starting gate prior to the start, made a middle move inside then drifted in during the drive. SOUPER DOUPER saved ground then was in tight inside in the drive. MASTER DAN broke through the gate pre start.
