RAINBOWS AND ROSES broke sharp, was well handled setting a moderate pace, resisted gamely when headed then came back again to get the decision after brushing with NATALIE'S MOMENT inside the final furlong. NATALIE'S MOMENT stalked the early pace, bid out of the second turn three wide to gain a short lead in the furlong grounds then hung late while brushing with RAINBOWS AND ROSES. SCORCHING was blocked and shuffled back into the second turn, angled inside out of the second turn then was gaining ground late. SMOOTH N EASY stalked the pace outside, bid after five furlongs to be a threat then weakened late. WEST SIDE MARIA made a middle move to be in striking distance out of the second turn but failed to sustain that rally. LOVER'S VENDETTA passed tiring rivals. THANK YOU DEAR failed to menace. CLAIRISY WARESY raced evenly. PYRITE JET chased for six furlongs then faded. NORTHERN TURNSTONE stopped. Following an objection by the rider of NATALIE'S MOMENT, RAINBOWS AND ROSES was disqualified from first and placed second. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
