RAISED FOR SPEED raced inside early, angled outside into the stretch then finished willingly but couldn't collar the winner while outfinishing the rest. GLITTERJAZZ broke slowly, was outrun early then closed a gap inside too late. JIM'S COVER UP pressed the pace into the stretch then weakened. SPECIAL AL chased to mid stretch then faded. E T TO THE MOON bid four wide then flattened out. DEPUTY CATON stopped. TWO TIMES GOOD was no factor. COLD SWEAT showed little. SKIPPYTIPPYTOES broke slow.
