NOTONETOQUIT pressed the leader much of the way, dueled through a long drive then was fully extended to prevail late. COWBOY HARDWARE dropped over while moving to a clear early lead, resisted the winner gamely to late then just hung. DISBELIEF chased the top pair much of the way then was slowly gaining outside late. SUMMER LEGACY made a wide middle move but failed to sustain that bid. BRIDE'S BEST BOY raced wide throughout. REPRIZED STRIKE was well placed for five furlongs then faded. LITE UP showed little. MYSIUS (ARG) trailed.
