RUNAWAY MARTHA was unhurried early, fanned seven wide out of the turn then ran past the leaders leaving the furlong grounds to be along in time. NEUF LA BANQUE (PER) made a three wide middle move, drew even with the leaders down the middle of the course in the furlong grounds but was no match for the winner while saving the place. SUGAH SUGAH fanned seven wide out of the second turn then lodged a mild rally late. INNOCENT REMARK made a middle move to be between rivals out of the second turn then weakened under pressure. STAR OF COLLEEN L. chased the leader, bid out of the second turn then gave way. WINLOC'S PILGRIM chased, bid out of the second turn and also gave way. MEGAN'S CRACKER was checked and steadied inside through the turn and into the stretch and failed to fully recover. ASTORBILT rushed to a long early lead but had little left in the crucial stages. SHEBAKAYSKITTYCAT showed little. CLASS APPROVAL lunged in the air at the start, losing all chance. There was stewards inquiry conducted into the start before the race was declared official.
