PUZZLE made a four wide middle move then rallied past the leaders through the furlong grounds to win going away. SING TO THE SKY pressed the pace much of the way, drew even for the lead after five furlongs then dueled to mid stretch but was no match for the winner while outfinishing the rest. UNWAVERING HONOUR rushed to the front early, set a slow pace to mid stretch then weakened. MAMA I'M HOME was blocked passing the quarter pole then closed a gap inside late. HOMEWOOD was blocked into the second turn, swung seven wide into the stretch but had no rally. WET N WILD MONEY was well placed but had no rally and came out in the late stages. YES MY LADY made a five wide middle move to contention then weakened before being in tight late. PRETTY PATTYS GIRL chased for six furlongs then faded. OLIVIA'S AFFAIR broke through the gate pre start but was prevented from flipping or running off by the assistant start then was through after a half in the running. SEA WEST turned in a dull effort. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
