### Footnotes

FIRE CLOUD made an inside middle move in traffic, got through along the rail to challenge into the furlong grounds then drew off late. COFFEE BAR stalked the pace early, bid four wide to gain a short lead into the stretch but couldn't turn back the winner while saving the place. LEROY'S PRIDE stalked the pace, bid five wide out of the second turn then weakened late. KITEBOARDING made a middle move to mid stretch but failed to sustain that rally. HURRICANE DAY passed tiring rivals. BAHIM chased early, bid in the second turn then flattened out. DA BIG DAWG also made a challenge in the second turn before giving way. SCORE'S EVEN failed to menace. LIGHT DAYS AHEAD chased outside then faded. ASHQUAR rushed to the lead early then stopped.
