WHY WHY WHY AMOUR chased past mid stretch before weakening. SECRET CANDY made an inside middle move then lodged a mild late rally. ROSESANDLIGHTNING was also making up some ground late inside. INCA BEAUTY chased into the stretch then gave way. LET'S GET READY failed to menace. WHITEY'S GOLD was well placed outside for six furlongs then faded. BOM BABY was no factor. MISS TEN OAKS trailed.
