THE REAL FUTURE rushed to the lead early, showed strong speed to set the pace then showed strong stamina to turn back STAR SNUCK when challenged in the final furlong. STAR SNUCK made a middle move, split rivals in the furlong grounds then after looming a threat outside the winner inside the final furlong, just hung late. FIRSLADY OF SPEED unhurried early, made up some ground late from between rivals. SECOND TIME AROUND chased the winner early, tried to collar that one after five furlongs then weakened. SIENA'S SPLASH raced evenly. CARMEL'S SECRET failed to threaten. BELGRADE LAKES was no factor. MORENAZA stopped. QUEEN'S CRUMPETS was through early. The portable inner rail was set at 22 feet.
