FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. Nominated to the Tampa bay Challenge Series. \$175 to pass the entry box with an additional \$175 to start with \$60,000 Guaranteed (which includes \$15,000 FTBOA Fund for registered Florida Breds) with 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. FTBOA Fund monies to be distributed as follows: \$7,500 for the first registered Florida Bred to officially finish; Followed by \$5,000 for the second registered Florida Bred; Ending with \$2,500 for the third registered Florida Bred. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$20,000 other than Maiden or Claiming, 2 lbs; three races other than Maiden or Claiming, 4 lbs; two such races, 6 lbs. This field will be limited to fourteen starters with preference given to those that have accumulated the highest career earnings. In addition, no same owner entry may start, regardless of earnings, to the exclusion of a single entry. For those that enter and are eliminated under these conditions, only the entry fees will be refunded. PORTSEA dueled for the lead for more than a half, shook free in the furlong grounds then drew off steadily when asked. LADY IN PINK was hustled to the lead and the rail early, vied with the winner to upper stretch but was no match for that one while besting the rest. JOYOUS SONG made a four wide middle

move to be in striking distance out of the turn but failed to gain in the drive. GALLANT SECRET passed tiring rivals. SHERRIE BELLE was blocked behind rivals inside into the stretch then split horses and lodged a mild belated bid. UNDENIABLE QUEEN failed to menace. MIDTOWN MISS raced evenly. ASHLEY AND I chased three wide to the stretch then faded. DARIAN SKYE was well placed inside but came up empty. QUEEN HYPOLITA was through early. QUIET OPTIMISM flashed brief speed. MUSICAL FACTOR failed to menace. TOOKE TOOKE stopped.
