NOW I'M MAD pressed the issue to the stretch then gave way. SICCARDI passed tiring rivals. LAST STAR was hung wide throughout. GROOM'S SPIRIT chased inside to the stretch then faded. NASHVILLE saved ground to the stretch then gave way. SHORT DANCER showed little.
