BLOWN TO SEA dueled inside from the outset, shook off rivals out of the turn then slowly pulled away under brisk handling. EXPECTED TEMPER pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, couldn't stay with the winner but saved the place. MADDIE K was off slow, was hustled along inside early, got through along the rail in the turn then weakened in the drive. FIRST ALY PIE pressed the pace to the quarter pole then gave way. MI BIENVENIDA raced evenly. QUEENS MONEY took up avoiding the stricken horse on the turn. SAM'S FOUNTAIN swerved out to avoiding a falling rival on the turn. WISHGIRL was off slow then checked behind the spill. NOBLE KITTEN also checked up behind the spill. RANG MY BELL broke down on the turn and fell heavily. There was a stewards' inquiry conducted into the incident on the turn before the results were declared official.
