EXCESSIVE HEAT raced close up early, bid outside the winner leaving the turn then was up late after a long drive. FLY EXPRESS vied for the lead from the outset, shook clear in the turn then resisted the winner to late before just hanging while second best. XPECTATION (NZ) raced inside to the quarter pole, angled outside for the drive then made up some ground belatedly. CHARLIE PAPA pressed the pace inside to mid stretch then gave way. QUEEN ERNESTINE raced evenly. LUCKEE MATCH pressed to the turn then weakened. EXCITEMENT (IRE) was no factor. INDIAN SKY flashed brief speed. DISCO DAMSEL showed little.
