DRUMSTICKS broke sharp, was unchallenged setting a moderate pace and was much the best while kept to pressure to late. OUR LEGEND stalked the winner throughout, couldn't gain on that one while besting the rest for the place. YUKAN B A LADY TOO was fractious in the gate, was unhurried for six furlongs then angled out for the drive and lodged a mild late rally. ADVANTAGE PLUS made a middle move to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. SO WONDERFUL was well placed inside for six furlongs then came up empty. HERECOMETHEGIRLS failed to menace. GRUB FOR GOLD chased for six furlongs then faded. SILVER TOUCH was through after a half. PEROXIDE LADY showed little. IMPRESS ME was through early. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
