MUSKET MAN chased early, bid three wide in the turn to gain a short lead, turned back a bid from GENERAL QUARERS through the furlong grounds then edged clear late. GENERAL QUARTERS looped rivals five wide out of the turn, drew even through the furlong grounds then hung late while easily second best. MILES AND MILES pressed the pace inside to near mid stretch then weakened in the final furlong. BOLD CAPTAIN was void of speed and passed tiring rivals. MEDAGLIA D'ONORE pressed inside then was taken up along the rail in the turn and failed to recover. A CENTURIAN vied for the lead to the quarter pole then gave way. GAARA dueled to the quarter pole then faded. A claim of foul by the rider of MEDAGLIA D'ONORE against MILES AND MILES for interference in the turn was disallowed.
