TWIN ENGINE settled off the pace, rallied four wide passing the quarter pole, dug in gamely between horses in the stretch drive and got the nod on the wire. O T B BOB raced off the pace inside, rallied five wide into the stretch, dug in gamely outside and just missed. RICO SUAVE stalked outside a rival, bid three wide on the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch and yielded late. PARODY tracked inside, waited for room on the turn, was shuffled back at the five sixteenths marker, then came three wide into the lane, bid on the rail at the eighth pole and finished well inside. CORSO'S LAW vied outside and faded. BOLD CAPTAIN was outrun. COUNTRY LYRIC vied inside and gave way.
