LUCKY LASS raced boxed inside for six furlongs, split rivals leaving the second turn to challenge, drove clear in the furlong grounds then had enough left to prevail late. ANOTHER SMOKEY made an inside middle move, got through along the rail into the stretch then was up for the place late. SHEHASHIGHOPES vied for the lead to mid stretch then weakened. MONSTRIP was well placed but lacked a strong late response. COUGAR CRUISE lodged only a mild rally late. THE REAL FUTURE was void of early speed then passed tiring rivals. HOGAN BEACH raced close up early, bid into the second turn then flattened out. GO ANNA GO raced wide early, dueled for six furlongs then came up empty. QUITE SASSY chased to the second turn then faded. THE LADY WAFFLES showed little.
