PRESUMPTIVE was never far back, bid four wide after five furlongs then dueled to late before shaking clear. FRESH ICE made a quick move after a half, bid in the second turn to gain a short lead then dueled to late before hanging while second best. CARROTS vied inside to the stretch then weakened. TIME FOR TUTT vied between rivals for five furlongs then gave way. LUNAR PUZZLE showed little. HUMMING ALONG stopped and was outdistanced.
