CABBAGE KEY was unhurried early, advanced after five furlongs then swung six wide for clear racing room and closed with a rush late to rally past. CLEARLY LUCKY vied inside for a half, drew off to a long lead after six furlongs but was no match for the winner late while second best. CHASING THE SONG flipped in the gate prior to the start, made a middle move to be closest to the leader after six furlongs but failed to sustain that rally. GOLD N' VELVET looped four wide through the second turn then flattened out. HARMONY FOUND checked behind an erratic CHAUTAUQUA BELLE in the second turn then failed to respond in the drive. DANICA raced close up early then checked into the second turn. BOLD EVENT vied for the lead on the backstretch then faded. PATIENT CAT failed to menace. CHAUTAUQUA BELLE dueled early then raced erratic while tiring through the second turn. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
