ROYAL NEMESIS stalked the pace inside, got through to challenge for and gain the lead a furlong out only to be caught on the wire. PICK FOUR stalked the pace from the outset, bid three wide out of the turn then was slowly gaining on the top two late. MANNY WHO lodged a mild rally inside. SONNY AND LOUIE was well placed but had no rally. FATHER JOHN raced evenly. HE'S APPEALING also turned in an even effort. KILN CREEK failed to menace. SALO JAK showed little. DEPUTY DANCE was through after a half. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE stopped.
