SENTIMENTL CONCERT broke alertly, set a solid pace under patient handling, shook off bids after five furlongs to regain a clear advantage then held sway late under pressure. LEVY LIGHT was never far back, fanned four wide into the stretch then was slowly gaining outside late. ESSA'S STORM saved ground for six furlongs, angled to the middle of the track for the drive then finished willingly but was outkicked. CA CHING THE GREEN got through along the inside in the furlong grounds and was gaining late. SHEGOESTOELEVEN stalked early, bid four wide after five furlongs then flattened out. JEAN THE QUEEN steadied in traffic after the break. BRICK BY BRICK was no factor. CATCH A THRILL chased early, bid in the second turn then came up empty. ALMOST PERFECT was through early.
