JOHNNY TORNADO dueled inside from the outset, drew off out of the second turn to mid stretch then lasted late under pressure. CHEF'S CHOICE made a middle move after five furlongs, angled out and was gaining on the winner late while best of the rest. STRODES LANE was forwardly placed but was outkicked late. ORCHARD PARK was well placed out of the second turn but had no rally. TITANIUM GHOST was stoutly rated for five furlongs and was no factor. COAHOMA broke in the air, made an outside middle move then came up empty. PINE FOR TATE bid three wide into the second turn then faltered. PLAY IT OUT pressed the issue to the second turn then faded. DEACON SPRINGS showed little. ABATARES stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
