HABAYEB stalked the pace for six furlongs, angled out four wide for clear racing room then rallied past the leaders leaving the furlong grounds to be along in time. QUITE THE GUY pressed the pace three wide, gained a short lead after five furlongs then continued well to mid stretch before hanging while besting the rest. LORD CHARLES closed a gap too late. SOUTHERN CARTEL dueled between rivals to mid stretch then weakened. NOVANTUNO dueled inside to upper stretch then gave way. HUP TWO passed tiring rivals. SHADOW WAVE showed little. BOWMAN TOO was through early. ANOTHER SKIP was no factor. MELLON BROOK ROAD stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
