EXCELLENT CHANCE was reserved well off the second flight while being guided to the inside in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention inside rivals in the second flight after a half, briefly awaited an opening midway through the far turn, switched off the inside following the leader's path to advance three deep between foes, drew on terms with the pacesetter midstretch, wrested command and kicked clear under some firm right handed encouragement. ACT OF MADNESS angled inwards racing into the first turn while leading the second flight on a narrow margin tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out three deep while continuing with a steady bid to wrest command racing into upper stretch, briefly resisted the winner's bid but proved no match late. MARS DEN, reserved while being guided nearer to the inside in the opening stages, steadily gained position on the far turn splitting rivals racing into upper stretch, angled out five wide racing through the stretch but continued with a mild bid to prevail for a share. BLUE DANUBE WALTZ tracked the leaders in second flight while switching outside a rival racing into the backstretch, advanced in tandem with several rivals while being caught four wide racing into the far turn to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker.

DISCREET DUKE was settled outside foes racing to the first turn, angled inwards entering the backstretch while making some brief progress between foes nearing the second bend but had no closing bid. ROVER, reserved last along the inside in the opening half, switched outside foes on the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch and gained some position while making no real impression. FRATELLO, caught a bit wide in the opening stages, never gained contention. CHIEF REDNECK switched outside foes to race four deep into the backstretch and soon retreated. ALFIE COME HOME, urged to press the pace inside a rival from the outset into the far turn, gave way racing into upper stretch. CALLMEBACK joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, dueled for command racing into the far turn and emptied out entering upper stretch.
