REIGNING LIVIA made a three wide middle move to challenge into the furlong grounds then edged clear from WYNNS AND ROSES late. WYNNS AND ROSES raced well placed early, bid into the stretch to draw even for the lead a furlong out then hung late while second best. DITCH THE ACT angled outside then lodged a mild late rally. GALLOP GIRL set a solid pace into the stretch then faltered in the final furlong. KISSY COCO raced evenly. FLEUR DE LILLY was through after a half. HELL 'N MAY trailed.
