Footnotes

PALACE BARISTA, within striking distance from the outset attending the pace while switching just outside the leaders racing through the backstretch, was prompted to advance while racing four wide into upper stretch but produced a steady late response to gain the advantage in time under firm encouragement. W. B. SMUDGE was urged to dispute the pace inside while shifting a bit off the rail racing through the backstretch, dueled for command off the inside into upper stretch and prevailed for the place honors while just failing to contain the winner. ONE BUCK ROMA was urged to force the pace outside a rival from the outset, dueled for command three deep into upper stretch and weakened between foes late. LAWYER DAGGETT angled inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing into the bend, angled out five wide near midstretch and continued with a mild bid. LACK OF JUDGMENT worked his way to the rail early tracking just off the first flight, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. ACTION ANDY broke readily, to gain terms with the first flight while under light rating, was caught six wide through the backstretch to the turn, shifted inwards on the bend dropping off the leaders, was urged to challenge five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. GOOD LORD, caught seven deep in early stages, steadily faded racing into the turn. SNEAKING UPONYOU, caught four wide between foes tracking just off the leaders racing into the turn, steadily faded after a half.
