CAUSE I SAID duled from the outset, continued gamely through a prolonged drive and was all out to narrow prevail late. CHORAL SOCIETY also duled much of the way, also continued gamely through the stretch and just missed in a game effort. EL CHICOTICO made a middle move, bid four wide to loom boldly late but was just outkicked to the wire. KIRBINATOR was hung five wide into the first turn, continued outside out of the second turn while rallying and also finished willingly but was also outfinished late. YENZEN made an inside middle move, got through along the rail to be a threat a furlong out but was outfinished in the crucial stages. VITIUM was void of speed to the stretch, swung seven wide in the drive then was gaining along the far outside late. RUN JAC RUN was through after a half. TRITONK was fractious in the gate. SAINT MUSKET failed to menace. VON CARLDOWN showed little.
