Footnotes

PALTARREVENGE, within striking distance in the opening stages while angling to the inside, was rated in hand dropping off the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued along the rail into the second bend steadily advancing to contention, switched outside the pacesetter nearing midstretch to wrest command and kicked clear under firm encouragement. GUTS AND GLORY, reserved from just out of striking distance behind the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, shifted outside the eventual winner while steadily gaining momentum racing into the second bend, shifted three wide racing into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's late kick but proved best of the others. CHIEF COCHISE, reluctant to load while delaying the start for several minutes, ducked outwards at the break, was settled into stride while making his way to the rail racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn to upper stretch but continued with interest to late stages between foes to gain position while prevailing for a share. KODIAK JACK moved readily to the fore along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin on his own courage into the second bend, held sway into upper stretch but bobbed slightly approaching the furlong marker and failed to sustain his momentum. SWAN QUARTER, caught four wide racing through the chute while moving to a contending position just off the leaders, was guided to the inside racing into the first turn while moving to a position inside foes in the second flight, continued with a steady advance to challenge just outside the pacesetter racing into the second bend but lacked the needed final response. HEY BUD, in touch between foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, steadily retreated after a half. MINTING MONEY broke awkwardly losing position to the field and never gained contention. STRIKE UP A STORM was never a factor. BELLAMY STORM was urged to gain a forward placing

three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch but gave way abruptly after a half.
