SOLDIER'S WORD stalked the early pace inside, got through along the rail to challenge into the second turn then after settling into the stretch with a clear lead, drew off steadily through the stretch while ridden out. SAVIANO chased the leader early, bid three wide into the second turn but was no match for the winner while easily second best. WRONG STREET sprinted clear, set a solid pace to the second turn then gradually weakened. HOWDY PARDNER made an inside middle move but failed to sustain that rally. MO'S LAST CALL passed tiring rivals. PREMEDITATED was well placed early then faded. SULTRY'S WISEMAN showed little. CHARISMIC AMERICAN was no factor. ROBYN CHIEF was through after a half. MT. GREYLOCK was no threat.
