**Footnotes**

MISTER DISH steadied inside in the first turn, angled outside into the backstretch, bid in the second turn to gain a short lead then continued gamely through a long drive before just prevailing in the final strides. DENALI SLEW steadied inside into the first turn, raced boxed through the second turn, got through along the inside to challenge into the furlong grounds then drew even for the lead late before just missing. HEY JOHNNY JOHNNY broke through the gate pre start before being controlled by the assistant starter, stalked the leaders early, bid three wide after five furlongs then dueled to mid stretch before weakening. STREET HAVEN was void of speed early then was making up some ground behind the first three late. BABYLON RICH was boxed through the second turn then failed to gain once clear. JACK'S ROMA raced evenly. ANDYS' BLU BUCKEYE was no factor. MR. SEABRA came in early, led into the second turn then faded after six furlongs. LUNA DE LOBO stopped. UNBRIDLED MON was no factor.
